**A MESSAGE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

Autumn is here and it's time to stockpile leaves and yard debris at the curb for pick-up. Please remember to sweep-up the curb line following pick-up to keep leftover debris from clogging storm drains. Autumn is also a great time to fertilize lawns. Be sure to use a fertilizer that is phosphorus-free, or direct your lawn care contractor to do the same. Phosphorus is a major stormwater runoff pollutant that contributes to excess weed and algae growth in our lakes and ponds.

And finally, always keep in mind that storm water runoff ultimately drains to our water ecosystems and therefore it's important to keep storm water as clean as possible to avoid impacting our natural water resources. If you see a situation that poses a storm water pollution problem, please call the our Report Hotline at 518-587-3550 x-2573 so the problem can be addressed.

Commencing with the July 2012 utility bill, there shall be an additional charge, billed quarterly, which will cover the cost of capital improvements to the City's water system.

Updated by City Council on March 20, 2012, "A separate charge of \$60.00 (sixty dollars) shall be assessed in all instances where estimated bills have been issued to an account for three (3) consecutive quarters."
